



Update on Mansour

It is eight months since Mansour arrived. He has done well assimilating into his new life in Canada. He maintains regular contact with Fr. Paul and Erin as well as with several Committee members. Whenever possible he has been attending services at St. Paul's and volunteers in support of church activities. Mansour continues employment at Crosby's Molasses and having proven to have a penchant for and being savvy with operating machines, has been moved up to run a "product blender" on one of the assembly lines. This is a more responsible job and comes with both daytime and night shifts. He has been told that this promotion will give greater job security after Christmas. He is happy and comfortable in his job. Mansour is happy in his apartment on Queen Square but because of the pandemic finds being cooped up a little frustrating. He will soon be faced with the decision of where he will continue to live when his current lease ends on 28th of February, if he does not remain where he is. At present, Mansour receives a regular bi-monthly salary from Crosby's, as well as a fixed monthly allotment from St. Paul's. The latter will end with a final payment on 25th of January to cover February expenses. Sufficient funds have been raised to support Mansour through to the end of February which is St. Paul's commitment. There will be a slight positive balance remaining after the final payment.
